INSTRUCTIONS:

1 GUESS THAT SPECIES

You need a friend for this game.

Person 1 picks one of the species on this page. Don't tell Person 2! You can write it down so you don't forget.

Person 2 has to figure out which species Person 1 chose by asking three questions, which can only be answered by 'yes' or 'no'.

Some examples could be: "Is your species extinct?"
"Can your species fly?" or "Is your species a plant?"

After three questions Person 2 has to guess the species.

Switch roles and play again! First person to three correct guesses wins!

2 BENTEMPUS BINGO

You can play this game on your own or with a friend.



If you see any species on the grid here at The Bentway, cross them off. For this game, sculptures of species can count as sightings!

See if you can cross off:

- all four corners
- a straight line
- a diagonal line
- an X

Remember:

Do not approach or interact with any wildlife you may find. You don't have to get close for a sighting!

"Well, this is hawkward..."




prehistoric ground of The Bentway

- Design your own creatures!


To make your own *Bentempus Gardinus* creatures, you'll need:

- a gluestick


*ask an adult if you need help




woolly mammoth




green frog
